What is MATCH Corps?

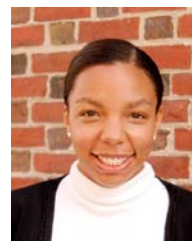
The MATCH Corps program began in 2004 – the first of its kind in the nation. The Corps is a group of 50 recent college graduates who work one-on-one with five Boston high school students each day for an entire year. This service year program is designed to fully close the academic Achievement Gap between minority students and their non-minority peers, one student at a time. Each Corps member works to guarantee the academic success of MATCH students while building personal relationships. Corps members also have secondary projects such as assisting teachers and staff.



Chris Brown graduated from Boston College in 2007. During his year of service in MATCH Corps, he tutors five students, pushing them to succeed academically.

How Can I Help?

Each Corps member makes a yearlong commitment to serving our students in exchange for a modest stipend and housing. AmeriCorps sponsors half of the Corps members, while MATCH must seek funding for the remaining Corps members. To ensure that all of our students continue to receive the services of the Corps, we need your help. Each Corps member is paid a modest stipend of \$7,200 for the year to give 5 students a chance at total academic transformation.



Nedra McLaughlin graduated from Princeton University in 2007, majoring in Economics. Nedra tutors five students and serves as a teaching assistant for AP Calculus.
