Weekly Course Summaries

Cluster 9

Pre-Algebra: In preparation for the final exam, students will review operations with multi-digit integers, order of operations, equivalent fractions, improper fraction/mixed number conversions, and fraction addition & subtraction.

Algebra 1: Students will review solving and graphing in preparation for the final exam.

English 9: Students will take their unit test on Shakespeare and begin reviewing key skills, definitions, and concepts in preparation for the final exam. The review will focus on theme, imagery, connotations, and symbolism.

Physics: Students will learn about proteins and nucleic acids. On Wednesday, students will review for Thursday's Unit 12 test.

Speech & Composition: Students will present their PowerPoint and Spoken Word speeches as the first portion of their final exam.
